A total of four lakes were stocked by the MNRF helicopter: Sprat Lake (3500 Rainbow Trout), Pencil Lake (800 Manitou), Bitter Lake (300 Gold), Concession Lake (300 Gold),

Now that most of our fish have been liberated we have only two tanks that need to be cleaned and fed: the Haliburton Gold fry and the Rainbow Trout in AR2. Please make sure that the AR2 screens are always on. When cleaning only remove one screen at a time. They have a tendency to jump out.

And speaking of stocking. The Haliburton Highlands Outdoor Association Stocked Lakes Guidebook is out. It contains all the lakes in the Minden District that are stocked by our hatchery and the MNRF.
